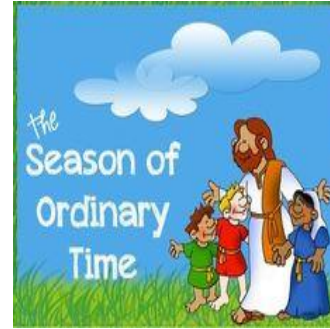
Thought for the week
